Dear President Fain and Public Review Board,

I, Frank Goeddeke, Jr., a retired member in good standing with UAW Local 653, filed a complaint in accordance with Article 32, Section 5(c) of our Constitution with our Public Review Board, July 10, 2025, and amended/appended on July 17. My local is not holding another membership meeting until at least mid-September, and I am trying to get this to you within the 30-day time limit of finding out.

I am writing now to append that complaint by including an additional instance of the IEB improperly delaying members' constitutional rights to inspect the IEB meeting minutes.

#### CHARGE 2: ADDITIONAL INSTANCE OF IMPROPER DELAYS TO INSPECT IEB MEETING MINUTES

The Public Review Board ruled in case #1866 that:

3) Going forward, the International Union shall make meeting summaries and verbatim minutes available in the manner directed under Article 12, §19 no later than two weeks prior to the next IEB meeting.

I asked to review the May 2025 meeting minutes via email to the Secretary-Treasurer and her assistant Brother Austin Bearinger on July 24, 2025. I was told in a July 29 email from Brother Bearinger that these would not be ready for my previously scheduled July 30 appointment to inspect IEB meeting minutes. At my July 30 appointment, I asked Secretary-Treasurer Mock when the next IEB meeting is. She told me it is next Tuesday, August 5 at Black Lake.

This is a violation of the Public Review Board order in case #1866 that these minutes be available "...no later than two weeks prior to the next IEB meeting."

Further, this morning, I went to my local, and the Financial Secretary was unable to find any IEB meeting summaries on LUIS later than June 2022. Article 12, Section 19 requires the Secretary-Treasurer to:

...prepare a summary of official International Executive Board action after each International Executive Board meeting, which shall be sent to each local union.

#### CHARGE 4: VIOLATION OF ARTICLE 51 SECTION 1

Article 51, Section 1 of our Constitution requires the Board of Trustees to:

The Board of Trustees shall designate a Certified Public Accountant to make such audits and shall incorporate same in their report to the International Officers, Board Members, and all affiliated Local Unions as soon as completed.

While I was my local this morning, my Financial Secretary was unable to find any international Trustee Report in LUIS later than June 2022. This is a violation of member rights in the Constitutional under Article 51, Section 1 as noted above.

Thank you for your valuable time and attention in appending my original complaint of July 10, 2025 as amended/appended July 17. Please let me know if I can answer any questions or assist you in any way.
