Hi Mr. Goeddeke,

The hotline does not share reports recommendations with reporters, but we are happy to share the process as it was explained to us:

For the official quarterly IEB minutes, a court reporter takes the verbatim minutes. However, for the *ad hoc* meetings, the Secretary Treasurer's clerical records the minutes and then types them up later. After the meetings, the minutes are reviewed by (in order): the Secretary Treasurer's clerical, the Secretary Treasurer's administrative assistant, the President's Office, back to the Secretary Treasurer's clerical to make the edits, and then the UAW Legal Department.

This was all the information obtained regarding the process, we did not inquire as to how disagreements get resolved as that was not the reason for the delays.
